Congratulations! Now that you have qualified for the DXCC TRIDENT Award by confirming (in the ARRL DXCC or Logbook of The World system) that you have two-way radio QSLs with at least 100 ARRL DXCC Award Countries (entities) on all-three modes (CW and PHONE and DIGITAL (Digital is any non-voice mode or CW {Eg, FTx, RTTY, PSKx, etc}), you can now purchase a wood plaque that proudly exemplifies your accomplishment – and is perfect to display in your shack.



The basic award is issued (and verified via your signature below) after you have confirmed two-way radio contacts with the required 100 countries on all three (3) modes when you apply, and that the ARRL Awards Department can verify your request by looking at your Logbook of The World dashboard (or in the ARRL's DXCC Award Credits data base). Endorsement levels of 200, 300 and HONOR ROLL are based on achieving that level on all-three modes at your time of application (Eg, 301 on CW, 256 on Phone and Honor Roll Digital, qualifies only for the 200 overall endorsement level – as all 3 modes must be above the endorsement plateau).

Again, the Award will only be issued by <u>using this form to apply</u> (at present, there is no electronic application within DXCC or LoTW) based on your pre-established DXCC credit accomplishments as recorded in our DXCC or LoTW Award records.

The earliest QSO date (and starting date for QSOs for this Award) is November 1, 1976 [when RTTY {Eg, Digital} DXCC was introduced (just a year after SSB and CW DXCC was added)].

No QSL Cards will be accepted with your plaque application (or be required for Award processing) – any credits intended toward this Award must first be obtained by standard application processes with the ARRL DXCC department. Then, when qualified per above, you can just complete and sign this form and submit it with your payment information below. The ARRL DXCC staff will review your application to ensure your eligibility based on DXCC records.

To order the plaque, please complete and return this form to the ARRL DXCC Desk at the address above; else you can also order by phone, fax or e-mail. As this is a new Award, and the demand may be very high, please allow 6-10 weeks for delivery in the US and Canada and 10-12 weeks for international delivery.
